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# RULES & REGULATIONS

## **THE LEX BRODIE'S TIRE COMPANY FOUNDATION HI5 RECYCLING DRIVE FUNDS-MATCHING PROGRAM**

- 1) To be eligible for matching funds, recycling drives must occur between August 1st, 2012 and March 15th, 2013. Schools need to fundraise independently.
- 2) One (1) \$1,000 (max) first place donation and one (1) \$500 (max) second place donation will be awarded. Winners announced in April 2013. Winners will be contacted by Lex Brodie's.
- 3) Any Hawaii grade school (public or private) is eligible to participate.
- 4) Recycling can be totaled from the entire student body and their families. HI-5 recycling receipts must be submitted and tallied. \*HI-5 recycling proceeds that are donated to the student's school will have a double count value. HI-5 recycling proceeds that are kept by the family are counted at the face value.
- 5) Recycling that qualifies; HI-5 recycling by students and their family members (and freinds), business recycling (which can only be added if the proceeds went to the school.)
- 6) Verifiable recycling receipts needs to be kept and tracked on an Excel spreadsheet prepared by the students and verified by a teacher or counselor from that school. Spreadsheet needs to include the following details for each recycling activity; date, material recycled, weights, recycling proceeds, acknowledgment the proceeds went to a school club, activity or fundraiser. Summary of the recycling will be turned into the Lex Brodie's Tire Company Foundation for judging. The Foundation's choice for the winners is final. Total amount recycled, the amount that was donated to the school, and the average recycled per student body (on average) will be factors for the winners.
- 7) The recycling program is to be run by students as a business and community support activity. A student group needs to organize the school program and track and document the recycling success. They will also need to rally the school's support, encourage grand results, and ensure the funds are donated to support a school or studentrelated activity, cause or service.
