CAUTIONE

WHEN CHANGING 2 TIRES

(and the tires are the same size & speed rating) the new tires should be installed on the rear of your vehicle to minimize loss of control when hydroplaning occurs*.



Other key ways to help prevent hydroplaning:

- Check tires frequently
- Put better tires on the rear
- Check & maintain proper air pressure
- Reduce your speed when driving in the rain
 - **Don't** wait until your tires are completely worn out before replacing. Wet traction falls off "significantly" as tread depth falls below 4/32nds of an inch.

*Possible exceptions: staggered tire sizes; remaining tires within 2/32nds of the new tires.
